

<u>Uniform Policy – Girls:</u>

We appreciate our families continued support of and adherence to our UNIFORM POLICY

- 1. Plaid Jumpers only available from www.flynnohara.com/1-800-441-4122
 - a. St. James plaid jumpers are required for ALL SCHOOL MASSES
 - b. St. James plaid skirts maybe worn by SIXTH GRADE GIRLS ONLY
 - c. St. James plaid jumpers/skirts may be worn to school daily
 - d. There are two styles
 - i. Split-neck Jumpers
 - ii. Drop Waist Jumpers
- 2. Slacks
 - Solid Navy Blue or Khaki Cotton Dress Slacks
- 3. Prohibited
 - a. No Cargo Pants/Shorts
 - No Stretch Pants
 - c. No Denim or Denim Fabric Pants/Shorts/Skorts
- 4. Shirts/Blouses
 - Solid short sleeve or long sleeve collared dress blouse or knit polo shirt with or without St. James logo.
 - b. Shirts and blouses must be
 - i. Solid White
 - ii. Solid Navy Blue
 - iii. Solid Maroon
 - **c.** Each student must have at least one dress blouse for mass
- 5. Sweaters
 - Solid sweaters must be either cardigan, zip up, or v-neck, with or without
 St. James logo. No hoody sweatshirts allowed.
 - b. Sweaters Must Be
 - i. Solid Navy Blue
 - ii. Solid Maroon
 - iii. Solid White
 - iv. Solid Black
- 6. Skirts or Skorts
 - a. St. James plaid skirts may be worn by SIXTH GRADE GIRLS ONLY
 - **b.** Skorts may be worn throughout the school year.
 - i. Solid Navy Blue
 - ii. Solid Khaki

Length must be longer than your longest fingertip when hands are down at your side.

- 7. Shorts
 - s. Shorts may be worn during the months of September, October, May, and June, or when announced by St. James—always weather permitting—only. No cargo shorts allowed.
 - i. Solid Navy Blue
 - ii. Solid Khaki
- 8. Socks
 - a. Socks must be either SOLID WHITE, NAVY, MAROON, or BLACK (no stripes or mismatched allowed)
 - i. Regular Length or Knee High
 - Navy blue, white, black, or maroon tights may be worn.

- i. Solid colored dress shoes or the uniform plaid dress shoes- white, navy, black, maroon, brown, tan (always worn for Mass)
 Please do not get patterned shoes or flashy colored shoes.
- ii. Gym sneakers may be worn daily except to mass
- b. Prohibited
 - No boots, open-toed shoes, Crocs, moccasins, sandals, platform shoes, or shoes deemed to be inconsistent with the SPIRIT of the St. James Dress Code

Failure to comply with the St. James Dress Code will result in

First Offense

A classroom warning and a uniform reminder sent home—requiring a signature—and returned on the next school day.

Second Offense

A classroom warning, a uniform reminder sent home—requiring a signature and returned on the next school day, and a call home.

Third Offense

Student will be required to wear the school uniform on the next non-uniform day and a call home.

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Girl's mass attire must consist of:

- St. James School plaid uniform jumper or 6th grade girls only plaid uniform skirt
- White, navy, or maroon button up dress blouse
- solid colored dress shoes –see colors allowed listed under shoes below.

Uniform Policy- Boys:

We appreciate our families continued support of and adherence to our UNIFORM POLICY

- 1. Slacks
 - a. Solid Navy Blue or Khaki Cotton Dress Slacks
- 2. Prohibited
 - a. No Cargo Pants/Shorts
 - b. No Denim or Denim Fabric Pants
- 3. Shirts/Button Down Dress Shirt
 - Solid short sleeve or long sleeve collared button down dress shirt or knit polo shirt with or without St. James logo.
 - b. Shirts must be
 - i. Solid White
 - ii. Solid Navy Blue
 - iii. Solid Maroon
 - c. Each student must have at least one button down dress shirt for mass
- 4. <u>Sweaters</u>
 - Solid sweaters must be either cardigan, zip up, or v-neck, with or without St. James logo. No hoody sweatshirts allowed.
 - b. Sweaters Must Be
 - i. Solid Navy Blue
 - ii. Solid Maroon
 - iii. Solid White
 - iv. Solid Black
- 5. Shorts
 - Shorts may be worn during the months of September, October, May, and June, or when announced by St. James—always weather permitting—only.
 - i. Solid Navy Blue
 - ii. Solid Khaki

Length must be longer than your longest fingertip when hands are down at your side.

- b. No cargo shorts allowed.
- 6. Socks
 - a. Socks must be either **SOLID WHITE**, **NAVY**, **MAROON**, **or BLACK** (no stripes allowed)
- 7. Shoes
- ii. Solid colored dress shoes white, navy, black, maroon, brown, tan (always worn for Mass)
 - Please do not get patterned shoes or flashy colored shoes.
- iii. Gym sneakers may be worn daily except to mass
- c. Prohibited
 - No boots, open-toed shoes, Crocs, moccasins, sandals, platform shoes, or shoes deemed to be inconsistent with the SPIRIT of the St. James Dress Code
